


Honestly, I am slightly taken aback and not exactly sure WHAT to say about this deeply moving and inspiring book. I got to the end and was flabbergasted not to find a "see what happens next in Book Two header" well even more than that I can easily say I was heartbroken. I had made a new group of deeply involved friends that I was completely invested in and the thought of not seeing a following chapter only added to the tears streaming freely from my eyes.

HOPE, I can, is a motivating factor in this book, it seemed to me. It offered HOPE of a beautiful and accepting world while acknowledging the ugly edges of bitter reality I have seen reach out and bite too many of my own personal family. Not family as in kinfolks, but "FAMILY" as most of my LGBT friends refer to one another as (and PROUDLY, I find myself included as "family" even though I am a heterosexual West Texas redneck). People seem to forget that Love is LOVE and that does not delineate a difference between the sexes or who loves whom. But, before I go off on a rant, let me get back on track.

This is a poignant and stunningly beautiful read from start to finish, this author was completely an unknown quantity to me, I had never heard of her and to be honest, I have never read a book of this genre before; I guess I just never thought to, but it won't be the last. I read it because I received an Advanced Release Copy with a request for a fair and unbiased review, a risky move on their part considering I am often a bit.....ummmmm, well—lets say more honest than many publishers are hoping for and point out editing errors and wandering plotlines etc. No worries here though, for I was smitten from the start.

The teen angst, romance, school spirit/activities, day to day real-life with friends and family; every aspect that makes ANY book a great read regardless of the genre, this books exceeds all standards! Inter-woven and closely developed characters come together in the beautiful of ways, they have the real life complexities one would expect, no punches pulled of BS flowed (Sorry for that, I realize it is not grammatically correct, but I DID say early that I am a Redneck!), the characters develop slowly and realistically, there is friction and tension; but more importantly there is LOVE and HOPE and ACCEPTANCE and a simplistically illustrated example of the perfect metaphor for an ideal family unit.
