Angel Aranda, an American writer, poet, and artist, is new to this reviewer, and if this, her first published book of poetry is an indication of her talent, she is an artist to follow. Her style is beguilingly simple while reading this extended narrative poem (a few words over a course of 150 pages), but there is something intoxicating about the rhythm of this narrative poem that pleads to be re-read after the entire affair is a thing of the past.

The title of this conversation between two lovers separated by time and distance and the vagaries of emotions reflects the poet's sensitivity, the Japanese words for `nothing lasts forever' - and perhaps at first reading the poem may speak to the reader about the intransigence of first love, but as Aranda expands her communication, we are able to hear the varied aspects from infatuation, to obsession, to the salvaging of those moments as time tests love, to discovering the universal spirit of love - transforming, exhilarating, durable despite distance and time. Yes, there is a lovely story of a young love affair here, but there is far more as the title suggests: love, like life, is constantly changing, and perhaps comes in cycles - of which this story is only one. And the manner in which Aranda allows her lovers to sail into the stars is just as palpable as the pain that can accompany a wounded heart. Angel Aranda is a welcome new poetic voice.
